



PANTS, LEGGINGS, AND EXPOSED UNDERGARMENTS

Jeans with holes, shreds, and rips will not be permitted

Pants must stay up at all times. No low rise or saggy pants revealing undergarments.



Please adhere to the following expectations during school hours and school-sponsored events:

- IDs must CURRENT and VISIBLE while on campus. The must be worn on the top half of your torso.
- No ripped pants may not reveal skin

No saggy pants.

- No crop tops.
- No spaghetti straps or exposed undergarments.
- No low-cut necklines.
- No clothing that displays the use of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, violence, or weapons; or contain inappropriate content with suggestive references; or support discriminations on the basis of color, disability, national origin, marital status, race, religion, gender, or sexual orientation.

SHIRTS AND TOPS

Strapless tops, backless tops, midriffs, and lowcut necklines are prohibited.

Strapless and sleeveless tops may be worn with a cardigan or sweater that fully covers all areas appropriately.

Shoulder straps must have a minimum width of a dollar bill.

Clothing must NOT display alcohol, drug, or sexual references.




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SAFETY AND HEALTH PLAN

REFUND POLICY

REFUND POLICY- SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA



Students will be eligible for a **full refund** of Adult, Postsecondary Career/Technical Education tuition and fees if the student is withdrawn within 5 days of the beginning of the class start date.



Students will be eligible for a full refund of Adult, General Education tuition, test fees and ID fees prior to the start of the AGE class or if the student never attends class.



Students will be eligible for a partial refund of Postsecondary Career/Technical Education tuition fees up to 5 days after the class start date. The partial refund amount will be equivalent to the total of class hours not attended. There will be no partial refund of Adult General Education fees.



Partial payments made for Postsecondary Career/Technical classes are NON-refundable after the start of class.



Students will be eligible for a refund of fees for Postsecondary Career/Technical Education courses less than three (3) weeks or ninety (90) hours in duration if the request for withdrawal is made prior to the second course meeting.

REFUND POLICY CONTINUED...

REFUND POLICY- SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA



A student is entitled to a full or partial refund of tuition fees if a course is cancelled by the school principal or designee.



Refunds when due, can be made without a request from a student. The refund must be made within forty-five days of the student's withdrawal date.



The application for refund by Check/Credit (Form 2057, Rev. 08-14) must be completed and approved for all eligible refunds.



Students withdrawn for disciplinary reasons pursuant to the Adult Student Code of Conduct are not entitled to a refund of any tuition and fees.



In cases of unusual or extraordinary circumstances (such as illness, death in family, etc.) that prevent a student from attending class, the school principal/designee may honor a request for full or partial refund of fees provided that:



The request from the student is made in writing (does not apply to students enrolled in a COE accredited CTE Program); And when appropriate, supporting documentation should be provided.

STUDENT PARKING

Students should **NOT** park in the Staff/ Region parking lot.

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No Tobacco or Drugs Allowed!

5512 - USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS AND SMOKING DEVICES

A tobacco free environment shall be provided for students, staff, and visitors.

"Use of tobacco and smoking devices" shall mean uses of tobacco, including cigars, cigarettes, pipe tobacco, chewing tobacco, snuff, nicotine dispensing devices, electronic cigarettes, smoking devices, or any other matter or substances that containing tobacco or nicotine, including any product designed or manufactured to imitate any of these products regardless of whether it contains tobacco or nicotine, and the possession of papers used to roll cigarettes.

The use and possession of tobacco and smoking devices is prohibited:

- A. within any indoor facility owned or leased or contracted for by the School Board is prohibited;
- B. anywhere on the campus of a facility owned or leased or contracted for by the Board, including, but not limited to, practice fields, playgrounds, football fields, baseball fields, softball fields, pool areas, soccer fields, tennis courts, all open areas, and within 1000 feet of a school;
- C. in all vehicles owned or operated by the Board, including, but not limited to, school buses, vans, trucks, station wagons, and cars.

Violations of this policy will be addressed pursuant to Policy 5500, Student Conduct and Discipline.





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
